	other policies we should have to prevent this from	
	happening again and Nickie will look for a safeguarding and	
	a GDPR policy suitable for RHSO which Rob will then put on	
	the web	Nickie
Maintenance	Adrienne reported that all the young trees had been weeded	
update	and fed and that we need to do this each year. She is	
	mowing the paths and will do it just before maintenance to	
	make moving around the orchard easier. We had a	
	discussion on the need to weed the ditches and decided no	
	need to do so this year. We will need to do the hedges at	
	some point where they encroach on the trees.	
	We had a discussion on the optimum time to plant new	
	trees and agreed on November and if a graft is needed that	
	should be done the summer before.	
	It was agreed that we need M25 size of root stock for RHSO.	
	This summer we need to compile a list of what we have, look	
	at a list of what is sold and then decide on what we should	
	plant for next year.
