Apple crop – Laxtons abundant, no coxes and few bramleys, plum yield good and pears prolific  Elizabeth spoke of the Memorial book that is in the archives which may show trees that have been donated – she will explore  After discussion we agreed that we need to record which trees have been heavily pruned so that we do not over prune  We thanked Adrienne for all her work	Elizabeth
